## How to apply for UNIGIS MSc (CE) study program with the Green-Egger GIS Scholarship

Send your signed application and related documents by email to [UNIGIS Office](mailto:unigis.office@plus.ac.at)

Application deadline is **September, 1<sup>st</sup> 2024**.

These documents include:

- A motivation letter, describing your (desired) field of activity and your goals. How could you and our planet benefit of your GIS study program. Also briefly state your financial situation.
- Signed Application form
- Signed Terms of Participation
- Curriculum Vitae
- Bachelor degree
- A copy of your passport or national identity card
- A very short (1min) video of yourself, explaining why UNIGIS is the right study program for you

### Tuition fee

The study program's tuition fee amounts to € 12,500.- payable in a single installment or 2 equal annual installments of – € 6,500.-. However, with winning the Green-Egger GIS Scholarship € 3.000.- are paid by our honoured sponsor Kurt Egger which reduces your individual tuition fee to **€ 9,500 (respectively € 3,500, second installment € 6,500)**.

The winner of the Green-Egger GIS Scholarship will be announced till September 9<sup>th</sup> 2024, the decision cannot be contested.

Please be aware, that this scholarship is also subject to the condition that the first three modules must be successfully completed on time, otherwise the scholarship must be paid back to UNIGIS Salzburg!

- Due date of the tuition fee is **September, 17<sup>th</sup>**.

The tuition fee includes all registration fees at the University of Salzburg (e.g. fees for university services, and the Austrian Student Union). Costs for the communication during the study time (broadband internet, etc.), for hardware, or for optional trips to summer schools, workshops or conferences are excluded from the tuition fee.

In case a student exceeds the study end date, no further courses or exams can be taken. It is possible, however, to agree on a **study extension**, which then is subject to an additional extension fee.

### Am I eligible for the MSc (CE) program?

To be eligible for the “Geographical Information Science & Systems – UNIGIS MSc (CE)” you need to

- hold a relevant Bachelor degree in a related discipline, i .e. either a “spatial” or an IT-related discipline, from recognised national or international universities.
- prove sufficient English language skills to read and write complex, academic texts.

The program director decides on the admission to the study program considering available study places, the application documents and an orientation interview.
