The tuition fee of € 9,500 (respectively € 12,500 without scholarship) is to be paid upon receipt of the invoice issued by the UNIGIS office. The due date is September 17, 2024. The tuition fee may be split into two instalments in case of which the first instalment is to be paid until the deadline listed above and the second rate is due before the start of the second year. All bank transfer fees must be borne by the sender (the applicant).

The tuition fee does not include any VAT and is non-refundable. The tuition includes all fees of University of Salzburg (e.g. library access, e-learning platform, software and the obligatory membership at the Austrian Student Union). Expenses for communication, hardware or optional trips to summer schools, workshops or conferences are not covered.

Please be aware, that this scholarship is also subject to the condition that the first three modules must be successfully completed on time, otherwise the scholarship must be paid back to UNIGIS Salzburg!

Upon receipt of the tuition fee the application is binding. In case the applicant withdraws from the program up to four weeks before start, a cancellation fee of Euro 300 will be charged to cover administrative costs. For any cancellations later than that, the entire tuition fee is due.

Software

Any software licences that are required in the course of the program will be made available free of charge during the entire enrolment period as active student. This is possible thanks to special agreements of the UNIGIS International Association and the University of Salzburg with software vendors. For detailed information on specific licenses, please refer to the websites of the respective provider. Make sure that your hardware meets the requirements of GIS software. In case of any questions, please double-check with the UNIGIS office.

All learning materials provided by UNIGIS are copyright of the University of Salzburg and / or the indicated individuals or legal entities. UNIGIS students (“participants”) are only granted the right to personally use these materials for studying purposes within the framework of the current UNIGIS program. Passing on of materials and any other use of materials requires the written permission of the copyright holder. Specifically, third party copyrights, trademarks and licenses are to be followed as indicated by the vendors’ terms and conditions.

All data, access and authorisation codes for IT services and infrastructure issued by the University of Salzburg directly or through a UNIGIS partner institution are restricted to the personal use of the student for studying purposes within the UNIGIS program in the period of enrolment as active student. Such data and services include for example, WebMap- or WebFeature Services, spatial data as data files or data sets which are part of the exercises and assignments. Furthermore, for the aforementioned data and services apply the terms of use defined by the holder thereof.

An e-learning platform is used to facilitate online learning and delivering learning materials. The e-learning platform is exclusively hosted on servers approved by the University of Salzburg and is maintained by an GDPR conformant external service provider.

UNIGIS does not accept responsibility for technical support, warranties, updates, and general questions for any software used throughout the study program – unless explicitly agreed otherwise.

The UNIGIS office supports participants during the admission and registration processes at the University of Salzburg. However, the responsibility for keeping the deadlines for submission of required documents to ensure the timely admission and registration at the University of Salzburg lies with the participant.

The maximum study period of the program is 36 months. If a participant exceeds this maximum study period, the enrolment as active students ceases and the right to receive further mentoring and assessment by UNIGIS Salzburg is terminated. The Program Director may grant an extension upon request by the student. However, an extension will involve additional fees at the rate that applies at the time the request is posed.

If tuition or extension payments are not received in due time, UNIGIS will cease rendering any services (e.g. providing of study materials, access to elearning platforms, assessment etc.) and require the participant to pay any outstanding fees to the University of Salzburg.

By the submission of this application, the applicant agrees that all personal data that he/she provided can be held and processed digitally by UNIGIS Salzburg for the following purposes: 1) The verification and authentication of the student status at the University of Salzburg and the UNIGIS International Association. 2) Semester-wise registration at the University of Salzburg. 3) Documentation of study performance. 4) UNIGIS Salzburg and partner institutions use applicant’s first and last name, as well as his/her primary e-mail address to license the required for the study program software products and the generation of a student account at UNIGIS industry partners.

The student is obliged to submit in writing any change of name or address within 4 weeks. Failing to do so implies that the last reported address is valid and all mail sent to that address is considered as delivered.

The University of Salzburg outside its sovereign administration is liable only for damage incurred through wilful or grossly negligent misconduct of its employees or staff.
