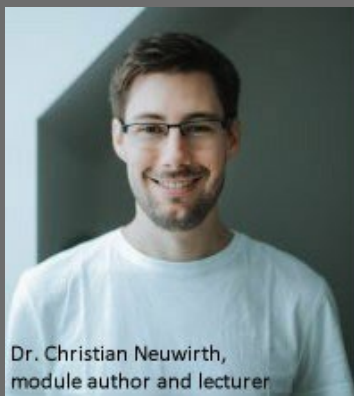

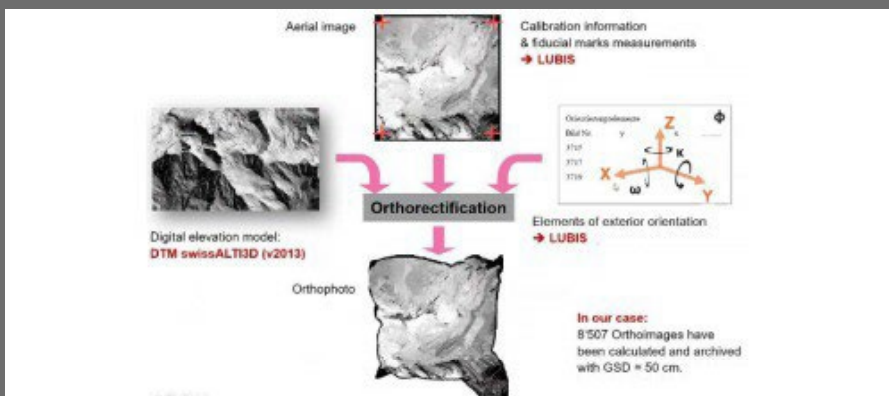

Holger Heisig publishes UNIGIS Thesis

Recent UNIGIS MSc student Holger Heisig took the challenge and submitted a manuscript based on his UNIGIS Master thesis to an international journal. His paper "Re-engineering the Past: Countrywide Geo-referencing of Archival Aerial Imagery" proposes a workflow to automate manual georectification with Ground Control Points by digital image matching. The paper got accepted in Springer's "Journal of Photogrammetry, Remote Sensing and Geoinformation Science".
