New UNIGIS members

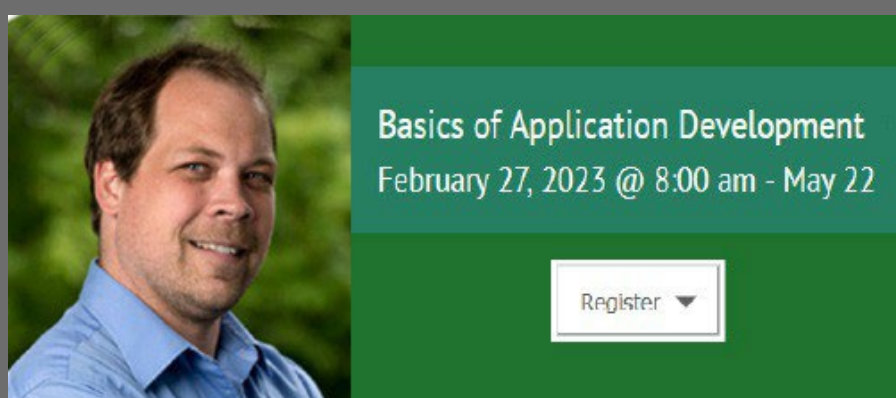

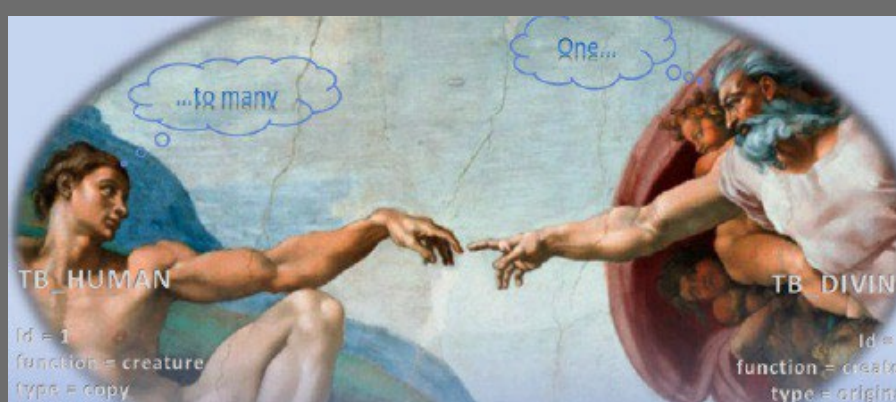


PLUS graduates met at the Thaddaeus Ropac Gallery in Mayfair, London

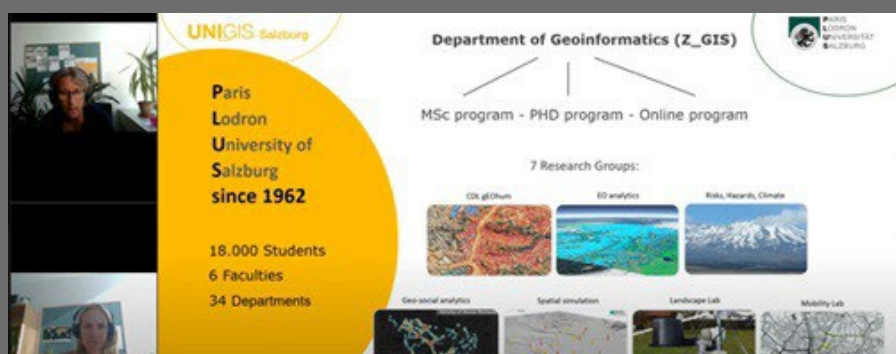
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Strategic partnership with IPGH
