UNIGIS: 30-year anniversary (UNIGIS offline Special Issue)

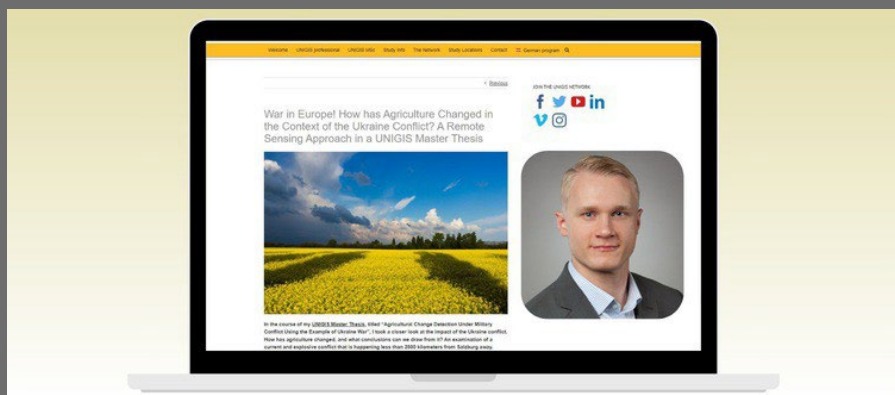
