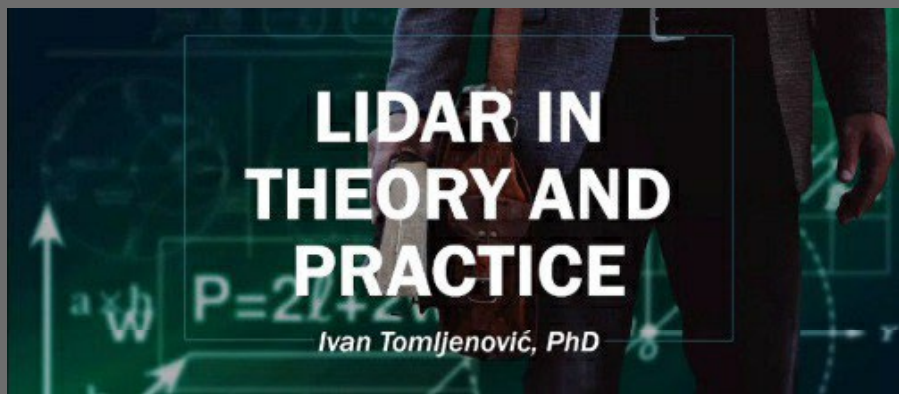


UNIGIS Alumni publishes...
